# **5. PLANNING AND APPEALS**

**5.1 To consider Householder planning application Ref DC/23/0382/HH a. single storey side extensions b. replacement windows and doors to all elevations c. cladding to all elevations at Foxdale, Felsham Road Bradfield St George Bury St Edmunds** The meeting considered this proposal and unanimously AGREED to SUPPORT in principle. Some reservations were expressed about the proposed colour of the cladding.

**5.2 To consider DC/23/0386/FUL Planning application - steel barn for storage of agricultural Machinery at Barn To North West Of Bilfri Cottage Felsham Road.** *The meeting recessed for public forum* 

The applicants in relation to this proposal provided background about the planning application *The meeting reconvened. TW did not participate in this item.* 

The proposals were discussed; it was noted that planning officers have amended the description of development to include demolition of the existing barn. It was further noted that a neighbour had made comments on the application to some councillors. Following discussion about visibility, screening (hedge height), the applicants' stated need for a machinery store, siting, size and height of proposed building in relation to the existing barn and the dilapidated condition of the existing barn, there was a split decision (3 in favour: 3 against). The Chair exercised his casting vote to decide there was **NO SUPPORT** for the proposals on the grounds that, in its current location, the proposed development would be unacceptably visible.

# 6. TO CONSIDER

**6.1 NALC correspondence on allotments.** NALC advice dated March 2023 regarding allotment use was received; it was **AGREED** that (i) the Nalc advice should be taken into account upon the next renewal date; and (ii) the clerk should raise an enquiry with SALC about donations.
